A further reward is the recognition of those who have been serving their Lodges as Ritualists in the past. Those heroes who through their sense of Duty and Love of the Craft have served as inspiration to us all.

Lodge Attendance and Visitation

Participation in the Ritualistic program promotes Lodge attendance because that is where we can do the Work. Visitation to other Lodges increases opportunities to amass points as well as enjoy fellowship within the fraternity.

Lodge Leadership

Program participation also encourages you to enter the officer-line. Many of the parts are regularly assigned to officers, thus allowing a “jump start” of sorts.

Record Keeping

Your recollection of the parts which you have performed from memory will be accepted on the “honor system” as a true record of accomplishment. The Grand Lodge will maintain all records.
